Educational Philosophy - 110

Delegation and Retention of Authority (116)

The Board of Education of the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District retains full legislative and judicial control, management, and authority over its schools and facilities in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin and the expressed will of the district electors. As provided in the School Laws of Wisconsin, the Board of Education delegates all executive, supervisory, and instructional authority to its employees as herein specified.

While the Board of Education is charged with directing those public school activities which the State of Wisconsin entrusts to its care and supervision, a carefully planned pattern of authority is observed by the Board of Education. To fulfill many of its obligations, the Board of Education gives direct authority to the District Administrator to act as its executive officer. The District Administrator is the chief administrative officer of the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District. The District Administrator is directly responsible to the Board of Education for the execution of all its policies, its regulations, and many of the other duties assigned to him in Board Policy 221.
