Qualifications (231.1)

The Building Principal shall:

1. Possess a proper and valid license for Principals issued by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction.
2. Present evidence from a licensed physician of their physical fitness to hold the office.
3. Possess knowledge and experience in the development and evaluation of curriculum.
4. Possess knowledge of child growth and development.
5. Possess knowledge and experience in the teaching and learning process.
6. Possess knowledge and experience in the development and maintenance of a positive school climate.
7. Possess knowledge and experience in the supervision and evaluation of professional and non-certified staff.
8. Possess knowledge of the Skyward Student Management system or other student records software system utilized by the district.
9. Obtain or possess knowledge in WSLs and ISES state reporting systems.
10. Possess knowledge in building level budgeting.
