Educational Program - 340

Driver's Education (341.4)

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District will offer the classroom portion of a Driver's Education program if a qualified instructor is available during the school year. The School District will make every attempt to set up an outside vendor to teach the behind-the-wheel portion of the Driver's Education program. Fees for the behind-the-wheel portion of the program will be established by the vendor and paid for by the student. Parents may find their own behind-the-wheel instructor or utilize the behind-the-wheel instruction worked out with the School District.

Students with exceptional educational or physical needs may be enrolled in a driver education or another form of traffic safety program as specified in their Individualized Educational Program (IEP).

All students are required to attend a minimum of thirty (30) hours of classroom instruction in Driver's Education. Failure to attend thirty (30) hours of instruction for any student will result in failure of the course, and the student will have to retake the course at a later date. One exception will be made for students participating in the European trip where extensive class time will be missed for participation in that activity. Students who participate in the European trip may make up the missed driver's education class time during the 4th quarter of the school year. There may be other extreme circumstances including funerals, long-term illness, early releases, or participation in other school related activities where the thirty (30) hours may not be met. Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the 7-12 Principal.
