Homebound Instruction (342.3)

Homebound instruction shall be provided for the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District students who qualify under state laws and regulations. Homebound instruction is considered an alternative service to be provided only during specific periods of time when the student is unable to attend school.

Specific goals of homebound instruction are:

- To assist the student to maintain academic functioning at as normal a level as possible during the time he/she is unable to attend school.
- To promote communication between the student and school community.

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education shall grant credits for homebound instruction if the amount of study time and quality of completed work assignments are equivalent to that normally received in the classroom.

Homebound instruction will be arranged by the Building Principal and Guidance Counselor.
