Students Assessment and Testing Programs (346)

Assessment Program Guidelines – 346.1 Rule

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District will have the following tests available for students who attend the classes in the school district:

- Wisconsin Knowledge and Concepts Examination (WKCE) – Required of all students in Grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, & 10. This test measures academic achievement in relationship to State of Wisconsin Academic Standards.
- Measurement of Academic Progress (MAP) – Required of all Students in grades 6, 7, and 8. This test records individual student progress during the school year.
- EXPLORE Test – Required of all students in grade 8. This test helps students investigate possible career options and better prepare them for selecting high school courses.
- Wisconsin Alternate Assessment (WAA) – Available as an alternate test in place of the WKCE for students with significant disabilities in grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 10
- PLAN Test – Optional test for sophomores. This test helps prepare students for the ACT Test.
- PSAT Test – Optional test for juniors. This test helps to prepare students for the SAT Test.
- ASVAB Test – Optional Test for juniors. This test analyzes the vocational aptitude of students.
- WIDA-ACCESS Placement Test (W-APT) – This test is used to identify students who may qualify for English Language learner Instruction
