Student Organizations (371)

Student organizations have an important place in the educational program of the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District. When student organizations are properly organized and operated, they:

- Extend and reinforce the instructional program.
- Give students practice in democratic self-government.
- Build student morale and spirit for positive support of the school.
- Honor outstanding student achievement.
- Provide wholesome social and recreational activities.

Student clubs or societies shall be recognized as school organizations when they meet all of the following:

- Authorization by school administration.
- Supervised by school personnel.
- Composed completely of current student body members.
- Hold a majority of their meetings at school.
- Establish aims that are educational and of school or community interest.
