Student Fund-Raising Activities (373)

Fund-raising activities in the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District are recognized as important tools in providing the funds that make many field trips and other events possible.

Fund-raising activities shall have prior administrative approval as follows:

- K – 6 fund-raisers shall have the approval of the Elementary Principal.
- 7 – 12 fund-raisers shall have the approval of the High School / Junior High Principal.
- Fundraisers involving the athletic department shall have the approval of both the Athletic Director and the High School Principal.

Door-to-door fundraising activities:

- Shall have the approval of the Building Principal and the District Administrator.
- Will require parental permission for participants.
- Will be prohibited for K – 5 students.

Organizations involved in fund-raising activities:

- Are expected to ensure that their fund-raising activities meet the guidelines provided by the district wellness policy.
- Must keep an accurate accounting of all monies derived from the fund-raiser.
- Will not schedule their fundraisers in conflict with the fundraisers of other organizations.
- Are encouraged to provide opportunities for direct contributions.
