Admission of Students Expelled from Other Districts (425)

Whenever a student seeks to enroll in the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District, the Building Administrator shall inquire as to whether or not the student is currently under expulsion from another School District. If the inquiry determines that a student, who seeks to enroll in the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District, is currently under a term of expulsion from another School District, the following procedures will take place.

- 1) The Building Principal and District Administrator will find the cause of expulsion. Any student seeking entrance into the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District who was expelled for drugs, weapons, or sexual misconduct will not be considered for entrance.
- 2) If the student has been expelled for other reasons, the Building Principal and District Administrator will analyze the following in determining if this student will be enrolled in the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School.
 - The student's academic records.
 - The student's disciplinary and behavioral records.
 - The student's attendance record.
 - The behavior(s) that led to the expulsion.
 - An analysis if the behavior(s) that led to an expulsion would have also led to an expulsion at NOW Elementary or Brookwood Jr. and Sr. High School.
 - An analysis of how this student would affect school and classroom climates.

The Building Principal and District Administrator may request an interview with the expelled student and the expelled student's parent(s) prior to making a decision on whether or not to admit the expelled student. A final decision on admitting an expelled student will be made by the District Administrator as soon as practical after the request for admission is made.
