Student Rights and Responsibilities – 440

Student Government (441.1)

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education sanctions and recommends the organization of two student councils, one in the Jr. High School and one in the Sr. High School. The primary purpose of each student council shall be:

- 1) Unify student activities under one body of control to promote the activities of the school.
- 2) Aid in the internal administration of the school.
- 3) Teach students the value of a working democracy.

Student Council Members shall be elected democratically. An advisor to each student council shall be assigned by the administration.
