Student Rights and Responsibilities – 440

School Age Parents (444)

A school aged parent includes any person under the age of twenty-one (21) who is not a high school graduate and is a parent, an expectant parent, or a person who has been pregnant within the preceding 120 days.

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education recognizes a need to aid young people who become parents prior to graduation from Brookwood High School. In order to aid young people in the continuation of their education, Brookwood High School will:

- Guarantee all school age parents within the district have equal opportunity to participate in school activities and programs without regard to pregnancy, marital or parental status.
- Make available to any school age parent in the district, program modifications and services that will enable the student to continue his/her education.
