Student Immunizations (453.2)

All students admitted to the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District must present immunization records as required by law. Except as otherwise provided, immunizations are required for measles, rubella, diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough), polio-myelitis, tetanus, hepatitis B, chicken pox, mumps and any other medical condition designated by law. The School Nurse shall annually review immunization requirements and has the responsibility for determining compliance with immunization requirements. The School Nurse is responsible for the maintaining of complete and up-to-date immunization records for each student attending the school.

Written evidence of required immunizations must be presented to the school district within thirty (30) school days of admission. The Department of Health and Family Services Student Immunization Record Form should be used. The student's parent/guardian will be notified of non-compliance after twenty-five (25) days. The district attorney of the county in which the student resides will be notified of non-compliance after sixty (60) days. Court action will subsequently be taken.

A student may be waived from the immunization requirement when the student's parent/guardian submits a written statement objecting to the immunization for reasons of health, religion, or personal conviction.
