Safety Patrol (455.4)

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District promotes the Safety Patrol program at the sixth (6th) grade level for the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Elementary School. Students at the 6th grade level who wish to be Safety Patrol members must pass the expectations and regulations established by the 6th grade teaching staff. Safety Patrol members will do the following:

- Monitor hallways during lunch and recess periods when practical.
- Monitor hallways during afternoon bus loading.
- Help younger students with the identification of the twelve (12) different buses and bus routes.
- Monitor elementary student bus behavior at the discretion of the bus driver.
- Be a role model of behavior for future Safety Patrol members.

Annually there will be a ceremony for outgoing and incoming Safety Patrol members. Also, there will be an annual field trip(s) for Safety Patrol members who meet all the expectations and regulations established by the 6th grade teaching staff in being a member of the Safety Patrol. The destination for this field trip will be organized by the 6th grade teachers and needs approval of the District Administrator.
