Students Scholarships and Awards – 460

Student Scholarships (461)

All scholarships or awards given by a group or individual to Brookwood High School must be awarded to any student who will graduate from Brookwood High School and meets the specific requirements for such a scholarship or award. A list of available scholarships for Brookwood High School Seniors will be posted by the High School Guidance Counselor.

This policy does not prohibit the organization or individual sponsoring the scholarship from establishing eligibility criteria on who can receive the scholarship.

When an individual or an organization establishes a scholarship with the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District, if the money to support the scholarship is given to the school district to invest, it will be considered a gift and the school district becomes the trustee of those funds. If the individual or organization wishes to maintain control over the funds for the scholarship, the individual or organizations must invest those funds themselves apart from the school district.

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District shall not discriminate in the acceptance and administration of gifts, bequests, scholarships and other aids, benefits or services to students, due to that student's sex, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability.
