### **Student Charges – 470**

#### **Student Fines (471)**

Students will be fined and assessed a fee for the following:

- Lost or damaged library books and textbooks.
- School equipment broken through carelessness of a student.
- Lost or damaged athletic equipment.
- Intentional damage to school building or grounds.

The following staff will be responsible for informing the student, the student's parents, and the building office of the reason for the fine and the amount of the fine.

- Lost or damaged library books and textbooks – Classroom Teachers and Librarians.
- School Equipment broken through carelessness of a student – Supervisor on duty who witnessed the careless action and the Building Principal.
- Lost or damaged athletic equipment – Head Coach and Athletic Director.
- Intentional damage to school building or grounds – Building Principal.

Junior High and High School students who fail to pay the fine can be denied the opportunity to participate in co-curricular activities until the fine is paid. Students may also be denied the privilege of participating in graduation ceremonies and similar activities. Students will not be denied the opportunity to take examinations, to receive report cards in a timely fashion or receive any other penalty related to the educational program of the student.
