Safety Program – 720

Every reasonable precaution will be taken for the safety of students, employees, visitors and others having business with the district. The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education believes that safety education and accident prevention are important to everyone involved with the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District.

In providing for safe and healthful facilities, the Board shall comply with all safety regulations, state codes and orders from all state and federal departments and agencies who specialize in health and safety codes and regulations.

The Head of Maintenance shall be responsible for coordinating all activities related to safe and healthful facilities. The practice of safety will also be considered a facet of the instructional program of the school district. Instruction in the areas of accident prevention, fire prevention, emergency procedures, and highway safety will be provided in appropriate grades and classes.
