The School Board of the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education recognizes that pupil transportation is an integral part of the total educational program. The time students spend on the school buses exerts an important influence on the physical and emotional condition which students bring to the classroom. The major objectives of the pupil transportation program are to:

- Provide safe transportation experience for all riders.
- Maintain a climate on the buses which is conducive to the emotional, social, and physical well-being of students.
- Operate an efficient and economical transportation system.
- Adapt transportation to the requirements of a student's individualized instructional program.

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District will offer and provide transportation to all students attending the school district who live within the school district's borders. Service will be provided only upon the public roads of the school district in a manner which will foster safe, dependable transportation to all students. Some special situations may occur which will necessitate the school district going into private driveways. These situations must have the prior approval of the district administrator.

Any approved transportation services under this policy may be discontinued by the district administrator in the event conditions such as weather, changes in bus loads, travel time, etc... shall affect the operation of the normal and regular bus routes.
