Use of Video Cameras on School Buses (751.4)

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District approves the use of video cameras on school district buses for the primary purpose of reducing disciplinary problems and vandalism on the school bus. Parents will be notified annually that video cameras are being used on the bus.

Disciplinary action may be taken with students based on video documentation. The isolated segment of the video that documents the incident may be viewed by the identified student and his/her parent/guardian. The video shall not be available for viewing by the general public, the media, or other individuals. School district administration may authorize other school district personnel to view segments of a specific video because of behavioral, emotional, or learning problems and viewing the video is beneficial to their role in assisting the student.
