Food Service Management - 760

Food Service Program (760)

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District shall provide hot lunches through participation in the National School Lunch Program. The District Administrator, or his/her designee, shall enter into an agreement with the Department of Public Instruction and the federal government for participation in such child nutrition program.

Required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District agrees to do the following:

- Offer a school lunch for all students that meets all federal regulations.
- Provide free and reduced price lunches for students who parents apply and meet the federal income guidelines.

The supervisor of food services shall be responsible for the management of the school lunch program, including all responsibilities outlined in Policy 563.1.

Lunch prices will be established by the Board of Education.

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton School District shall not discriminate in school-sponsored food service programs on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, color, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
