Dear N-O-W Families:

We hope you are staying healthy. The Monroe County Health Department recommends that if a school has between 10-20% of absences due to COVID risks, the school should go virtual. Due to the number of positive cases of COVID-19 in our communities and the ensuing percentage of students quarantined, we will be ***transitioning our 4K through 6th grade students to a virtual learning model beginning Monday, October 19. 7th-12th grade students will complete another week of virtual learning the week of Monday, October 19. Therefore, all N-O-W students will be virtual from Monday, October 19 through Friday, October 23.***

To clarify, Pre-K through 6th grade students in the N-O-W School District will attend school in person tomorrow, October 13, 2020 and Wednesday, October 14, 2020 (as long as students are not symptomatic or have been told to quarantine). Pre-K through 6th grades students WILL NOT have school on Thursday, October 15 or Friday, October 16. (Students in grades 7-12 will continue with virtual learning, following the same expectations for virtual learning.)

4K Students

4K students will receive packets with games and activities that they can work on at home.

Kindergarten - 6th grade expectations

Students will be assigned daily assignments; it is up to the parents' discretion as to when, during the day, the assignments are completed. All assignments must be completed as directed by the teacher. Grades will be assigned just as they would be during normal face-to-face school time.

Students in Kindergarten - 3rd grade will do their daily work through Seesaw. Teachers in grades K - 3rd grades may offer face-to-face sessions with students to check in with students. Alternate assignments may be given for those without internet services.

Students in 4-6th grade will work in the Google platform. Teachers in grades 4-6th grades may have face-to-face sessions with students to deliver lessons and to check in with students. Alternate assignments may be given for those without internet services.

Teachers of all students will be available to answer questions or help with issues during their office hours. Each teacher will also send a letter with more specific details regarding his/her classroom procedures during virtual learning.

The above guidelines apply to both regular and special education classes.
