Dear N-O-W Families:

We hope you are staying healthy.

Due to staffing concerns, we will be **transitioning our 7th-12th grade students to a virtual learning model beginning Monday, October 12**. At this time, virtual learning is planned for one week (the week of October 12-16).

Note: Pre-K through 6th grades will remain in-person as normal.

To clarify, all students in the N-O-W School District will attend school in person tomorrow, October 7, 2020 (as long as students are not symptomatic or have been told to quarantine). Students in grades 7-12 will NOT attend school in person from Thursday, October 8 through Friday, October 16. Students in grades 7-12 will begin virtual learning on Monday, October 12. (Students may still have assignments to turn in on 10/8 or 10/9, but no new lessons or assignments will be given).

Tomorrow during Falcon Time (first class meeting period of the day), students will be reviewing learning expectations with their students. What students in grades 7-12 will be reminded of tomorrow:

- 1.) 7-12th grade students will not be in school or have virtual learning Thursday or Friday.
- 2.) If there was an assignment given by a teacher earlier in the week with a due date of Thursday or Friday, the teacher can still choose to require that assignment to be due Thursday or Friday. The teacher will NOT be assigning anything new (no new lessons) Thursday or Friday.
- 3.) 7-12th grade virtual instruction will start on Monday, October 12 and go through Friday, October 16.
- 4.) There are expectations for virtual learning. To see an overview, please click [HERE](#). Note: students' attendance will be taken (reference the document to find out how).
- 5.) Students should bring all class materials needed home with them tomorrow (10/7). This includes students' laptops, necessary books, etc.
- 6.) If students were sent home due to quarantine, please call the school to inform us of what the student needs. We will gather materials and arrange a time for you to pick them up.
- 7.) If you have difficulties with Internet access, please contact the school at 608-337-4401. We will discuss options (hotspots or picking up paper copies).
- 8.) Food Service is available to our students during virtual learning. Please see the Food Service letter.

Again, all students in Pre-K through 6th grades will continue with in-person instruction at this time. Please call the school at 608-337-4401 with questions.
