Extra Curricular Activities and Programs (370)

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education believes that student activities at the school are a vital part of the total educational program and should be used as a means for developing whole-some attitudes and good human relations, as well as knowledge and skills. The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education believes that school citizenship, as reflected in student activities, is a measure of the achievement of important school goals. Also, the Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education recognizes that the greatest values to be derived from both curricular and extracurricular student school activities occur when such activities are developed and encouraged through participation among, or the knowledge of, the student body, interested members in the community, and school staff.

The Norwalk-Ontario-Wilton Board of Education also believes that any program of student activities should:

- Require all student participation be on a voluntary basis.
- Require that the student activity funds should be used for purposes which benefit the student body of the school.
- Not discriminate against pupils on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap.
