- Driver's Ed / Summer Course: Brookwood will offer a Driver's Education class during summer school (June 3rd 20th). The behind-the-wheel portion with an instructor from Driving Stars LLC will take place when school resumes in the fall. Students will receive .250 credit for the class. The cost is \$300. Students must be at least 14 & ½ years old at the time of the class to be eligible to participate. (Letters have been mailed home to these students.) Driver's Education requires 30 hours of classroom time, so if your child is absent more than 1 day they will not pass the class. (State law only allows students to miss one class period.) Class days/hours are Monday-Thursday, 8:00am 12:00pm classroom time. The class is limited to 27 students and we accept students from oldest to youngest.

In the Water Action Volunteer program citizen scientists collect baseline information for monitoring stream quality. WAVers survey a stream monthly from May into October, gathering parameters such as temperature, dissolved oxygen, turbidity, flow rate and biotic index. Attendees will learn about these steps and how to become involved. Ben Johnston has been involved with Citizen Science for many years. In addition to counting birds, bats, frogs, plants, and other natural things, he has been appointed local WAV coordinator for the Valley Stewardship Network.
